# ROGUE VALLEY TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT

## REGULATIONS GOVERNING ACCESS TO DISTRICT VEHICLES AND STATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IN-PERSON SOLICITATION OF SIGNATURES

Pursuant to the Rogue Valley Transportation District (RVTD) Ordinance No. 8, Sections 102(4)(a), (5)(c) and (d), and (7)(a), governing interference with safe, unobstructed access to and use of District vehicles, property, and services, the General Manager issues the following regulations concerning in-person solicitation of signatures.

Signature gathering on District property will be allowed, with written permission, when the following conditions are met:

- No person shall obstruct or set up tables, chairs, or signage which obstruct the safe, unobstructed movement of passengers within any District vehicle, or at any transit stop or station.
- No person shall interfere with the operation or movement of any District vehicle.
- No solicitation will occur on/in District vehicles.
- No tables, chairs, signage, solicitation, etc., will be set up or take place on the curbside of sidewalks at District transit stops and stations.
- No person shall, while soliciting, occupy station or transit stop seating that would otherwise be used by District customers.
- No person, in soliciting signatures, shall speak or behave in a loud, boisterous, or intimidating manner which would be considered an annoyance or threat to District customers.
- The person seeking to gather signatures, or the entity sponsoring such an activity must have received written approval from the RVTD General Manager, or his/her designee. A form for requesting and receiving such approval is set forth on the back of this page, or the page that follows.

These Regulations are issued this 24<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2004, and are effective as of the date hereof.
