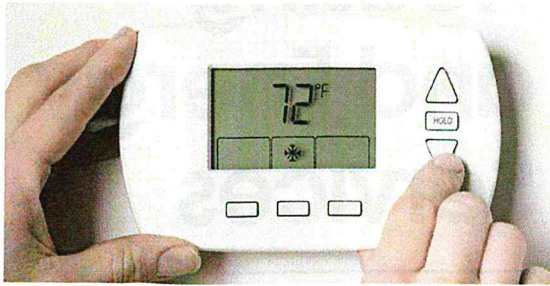
Energy Assistance

Provides assistance with heating bills. Eligibility varies by program. Inquire at local CSC office for availability and eligibility requirements:

Weatherization

Installation of insulation, weather stripping, and other measures as needed to make your home warmer in winter and more energy efficient. Free to qualifying home owners and renters. Inquire at local energy assistance office or call 541-758-2627.

Energy Education

Free workshops for energy assistance recipients that teach you how to save energy and \$\$\$ on your utility bills. Also, in-home inspections available to show you how efficient your home is and what you can do to make it more comfortable. Inquire at your local energy assistance office to sign up open.

Rental Assistance

Help with rent and/or security deposits. Eligibility varies by program. Inquire at local CSC office for availability and eligibility requirements:

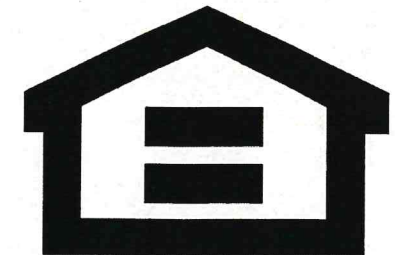


Second Chance Renter's Rehabilitation
