



2021 ATU 757 OFFICER ELECTION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is happening?

All active and retired members of ATU Local 757 are voting to elect officers to represent them in contract negotiations, in disciplinary meetings, at the International ATU Convention, and much more. This includes all positions higher than shop steward: the full-time at-large offices of President, Vice President, and Financial Secretary/Treasurer, as well as Executive Board Officers, and Liaison Officers. (Retired members vote only on the three full-time at-large offices.) Once elected, these officers will serve from July 1, 2021 until June 30, 2024.

How do I vote?

The election will be held by mail. Ballots will be mailed no later than Monday, May 24, 2021. The ballot you receive will include races for offices based on the location where you were working as of the date of the nomination meeting, May 10, 2021. Read the instructions included with your ballot carefully, fill out your ballot, and return it as soon as you can. To be counted, ballots must be received in the Union PO Box by 9:00 a.m., Wednesday June 16, 2021.

When and where is the ballot count?

The ballots will be tallied by an impartial third party vendor, TrueBallot, Inc., under the supervision of the Election Committee on Wednesday, June 16, at the Monarch Hotel in Clackamas, OR. Members and candidates will be allowed to observe the ballot count.

Who is running?

A nomination meeting was held via Zoom on Monday, May 10, 2021 and nominations and acceptances were received live or read into the record if they had been submitted in writing ahead of time. For a complete list of nominees
