Subject: ATU Election Campaign and Promotion Materials on District Premises

Lane Transit District, as the stewards of District property, will grant permission for candidates to post and distribute their campaign promotional materials on District premises. We ask all candidates to follow the guidelines below:

1. ATU campaign material may be posted at designated LTD facilities only, as specified in item two, beginning the day after official nominations for Union positions are held. Campaign material must be removed no later than the day after results of the primary election results are announced, with one exception: Those candidates competing in a general election will be required to remove their campaign material from LTD facilities no later than the day after results of the general election are announced.
2. Union campaign signs will be limited to a maximum size of 8.5" x 11", and only one sign per candidate may be posted at each of the following LTD facilities:
 - In the glass case in the hallway outside the operators' lounge at Glenwood
 - In the lunchroom at Fleet Services
 - On an approve bulletin board in the operators' lounge at the Eugene Downtown Station
 - On an approved bulletin Board in the CSC employee area.
3. All campaign posters or signs displayed must be signed and dated by the candidate. Any poster or sign not signed and dated by the candidate will be removed.
4. No campaign or campaign-related materials of any kind will be permitted on or at any other LTD facility, other than as provided for in paragraph two, above. Handouts, fliers, information sheets, or any other form of campaign-related materials will not be allowed on tables or any other place in or surrounding LTD facilities and will not be distributed in the operator mail boxes.
5. No campaign materials will be posted by anyone who is on a paid, "on the clock" status.
