Candy,

While it is preferred that ATU meet with union members virtually, if there is a need to be in-person at the Public Works site, all protocols listed below must be strictly followed.

### Vendor/Contractor Access Protocols:

Vendors/Contractors may not work on a City site if they have any of the COVID-19 symptoms.

- Vendors/Contractors will be work on-site in facilities where City employees are also working only with advance notice of when and where they will be working.
- Vendors/Contractors will be greeted and informed about City protocols if working in a facility with City employees.
- Vendors/Contractors working independently (i.e., not in a facility with City employees) must be notified that they need to follow City protocols for physical distancing and should consider signage to keep community members back from the work area.

Vendors/Contractors are expected to abide by the City's protocols for access, sanitation, and PPE for employees, including:

- Vendors/Contractors are expected to wear face coverings at all times.
- Vendors/Contractors will wipe down surfaces they touch that could be touched by others when they are done.
